
### Australia




- DAB+ listening on the rise 4.21 million people listen weekly in the five metro capital cities up 17% compared to same time last year (average of surveys 1-6, 2018).
- 4.44m DAB+ devices in market.
- Cars providing strong impetus 60% of all new vehicles sold in past year fitted with DAB+.
- Average time spent listening via DAB+ is 10 hrs 34 mins per week, nearly double TSL via streaming
- Broadcasters investing in station development:
  - New stations include Urban Hits and Triple M Country
  - Coles Radio introduced a 3-hour daily announcer hosted show, providing new sponsor opps
  - Chemist Warehouse Remix offering hosted breakfast and drive shows and hourly news, sport and weather.
















### Australia



- Australian DAB+ stations now easily accessible on all Amazon Alexa-enabled smart speakers following the launch of the RadioApp skill. Listeners can simply ask Alexa to play 300 Australian AM, FM and DAB+ stations using their voice.
- Work continues on launch of permanent commercial DAB+ services in Hobart, Canberra & Darwin in Q1 2019, capex and opex cost modelling has been completed.
- CRA supporting hybrid radio testing and development to improve the in-car experience
- Partnering with a DAB+ manufacturer on a Christmas marketing campaign





# Asia Pacific update



#### **MALAYSIA**

- Significant change of Government for first time since independence in 1957. MCMC has appointed a UK based consultant to prepare a report on the selection of digital radio technology standard.
- MCMC has been approached by WorldDAB to offer in country support to help them move forward with the formalisation process for DAB+.
- ABU Digital Broadcasting Summit 4-7 March 2019

#### **INDONESIA**

- Ministry of Communications Kominfo opened a public consultation on Draft Regulation Technical Requirements Tool Transmitter Radio Digital Audio Broadcasting (DAB +) as part of a broader regulatory package. Consultation opened on 26 July & closed August 2nd, 2018
- No mention of any other digital radio standards.





# Asia Pacific update



#### **SRI LANKA**

- WorldDAB has been approached to conduct a workshop in Colombo in November.
- A formal letter of support is being sought from the regulator and national broadcaster.

#### **MYANMAR**

- Myanmar National Broadcaster, MRTV continue the DAB pilot project they started in August 2016 with services in Yangon.
- There is interest from another influential operator in Myanmar to mount a DAB+ trial.
